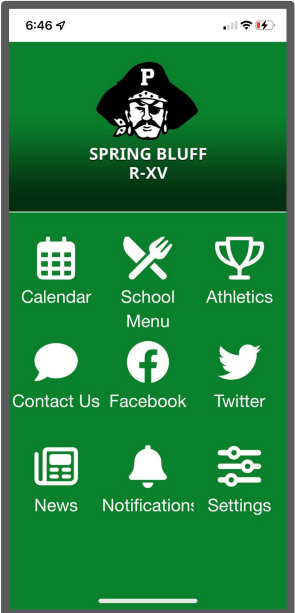


# WHAT'S UP AT THE BLUFF
