The Beaufort/Leslie Fire Department came to visit our Kindergarten and First Grade students this week!

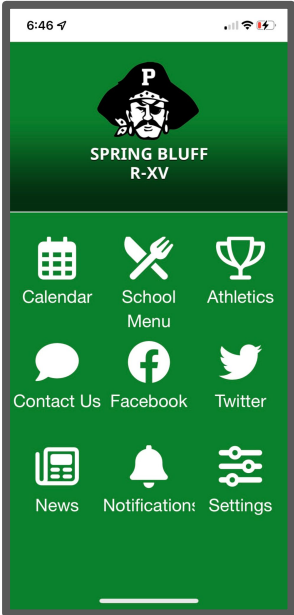


AFTER SCHOOL CLUB FUN!
