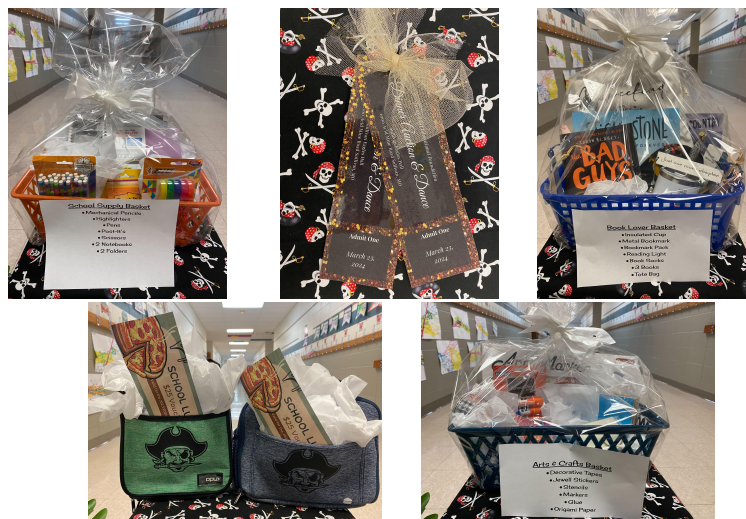

PARENT/GUARDIAN REGISTRATION LETTER

Please be advised that each parent or guardian planning on attending a field trip will need to complete the steps for Parent & Guardian Registration. Here are the basic steps:

- Register online with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services [FCSR-BSEES](https://www.fcsr-bsees.com).
 - This only needs to be done once per lifetime.
 - There is a one-time registration fee of \$15.25, payable to MO DHSS.
- Complete the Guardian Registration Form
 - This will need to be completed each school year and is attached in this email. Send this back to school.
- Complete a check against the National Sex Offenders Registry by scanning your driver's license in the office.
 - This needs to be completed within a week of each trip.

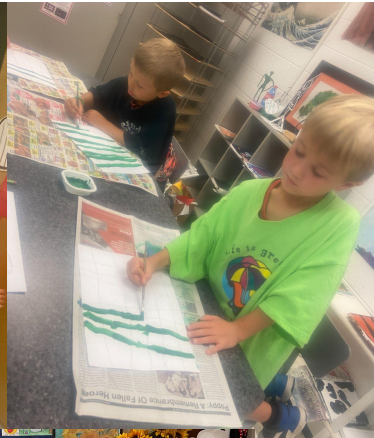

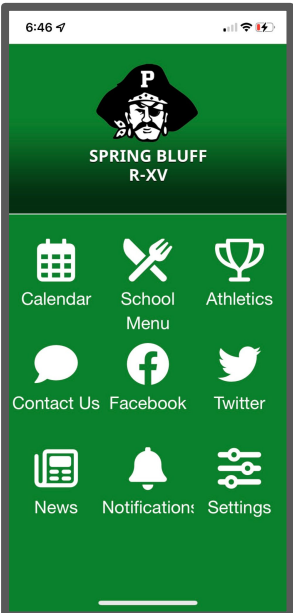
