- Register online with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services FCSR-BSEES.
 - This only needs to be done once per lifetime.
 - There is a <u>one-time</u> registration fee of \$15.25, payable to MO DHSS.
- Complete the Guardian Registration Form
 - This will need to be completed <u>each</u> school year and is found on the school's website. Send this back to school.
- Complete a check against the National Sex
 Offenders Registry by scanning your driver's license in the office.
 - This needs to be completed within a week of each trip.


