Tips from Title I

Each week I will provide you with a tip or two on how you can help your child become a better reader. Over the next few weeks I would like to focus on the middle grades, 3-5. I will be sharing some of the best research-based ideas to help your middle grade learners improve their reading abilities outside of school. This week's tip is:

Read: There are multiple positive effects of students being read to and students seeing their family read. If we want our learners to read, we have to walk the walk. By reading, your learner builds positive associations with reading, is willing to take reading risks, and is exposed to significantly more vocabulary. Take some time this week and let your child see you sit down with a good book. You will all enjoy yourselves!

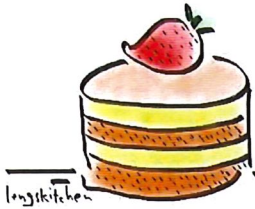

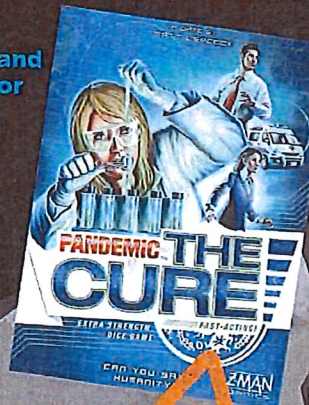
