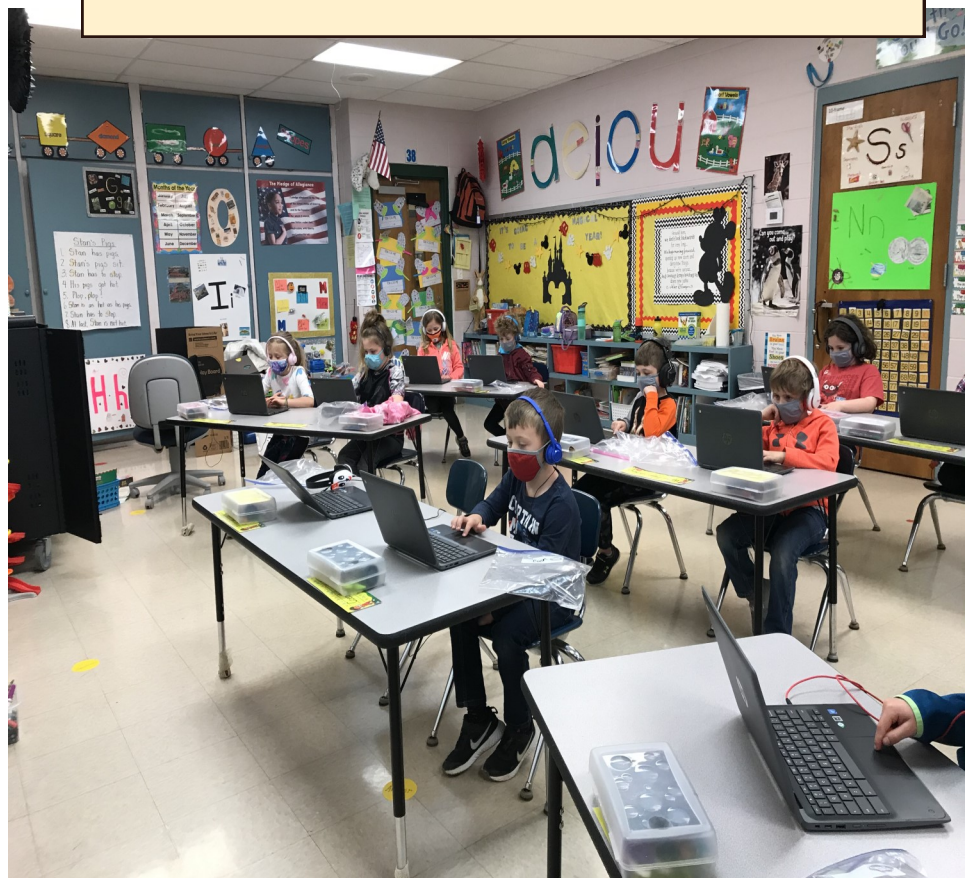
Spring Bluff is a 1:1 School, grades K-8
