We will begin offering the Antigen testing on September 27th. Consent forms will be sent home to parents next week, no student will be tested without parental consent. The Spring Bluff R-XV Rubric for COVID-19 Exposure within the School Environment was updated. Data will be reviewed on a daily and weekly basis. Transitioning between the levels will occur when the criteria is met for each level. Once the school has transitioned to a level, we will remain in that level for a minimum of 10 days and data will be evaluated using data from the last three student attendance days before transitioning left or right on the rubric.
