YELLOW Zone-Masks Required Starting 11.12.21 We have seen an increase in the number of positive COVID-19 cases in the building for three consecutive days.

Starting Friday, November 12, we will be following the mitigations outlined in the attached rubric for the **YELLOW** zone. Students and staff will be required to wear a mask indoors when social distancing of 3ft or more cannot be maintained. Students will need to come prepared with a mask of their choice or a cloth one will be provided for them.

Please read the attached rubric for the changes we will be following starting tomorrow, Friday November 12. We will continue to monitor data and adjust our mitigation strategies identified in the rubric as needed. We will remain in the **YELLOW** zone for a minimum of 3 student attendance days. Parents will be notified by 3 p.m. on November 16, if criteria has been met to transition out of the **YELLOW** zone.
