IDEAS FOR MASTERING SIGHT WORDS AND SPELLING WORDS

*Practical Strategies for Raising
Kids Who Love to Read and Write
with Dr. Dace*

Sky writing

1

Stand up. Stretch out your arm and "write" your word in the air with through tracing each of the letters in the word. Why this works: the same neurons in your fingers that stretch all the way up your arm into your brain connect to the part in your brain that memorizes how to spell words.

2

Write your sight words in red

When you need to memorize how to spell words, write the words in red. Red is a brain friendly color for memorization.

3

Sort your words into like groups

When learning a new spelling pattern, it helps to see which words in the list have the same pattern. Sort the words into like groups and then use the same color to represent the letters that are the same in the words. This makes it easier for our brains to recognize and remember the spelling patterns.

Kindergarten enjoyed their community field trip last week to the fire station, library, and park.

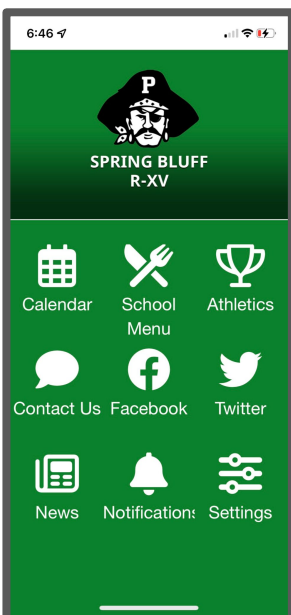




During the Teacher Work Day on 9/30/22, additional teachers and staff earned their CPR certification.
