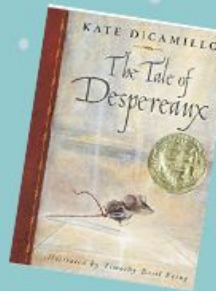

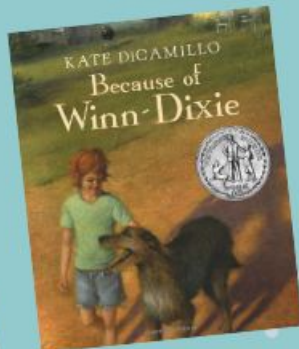

I think this part fits with the overall mystery, because...

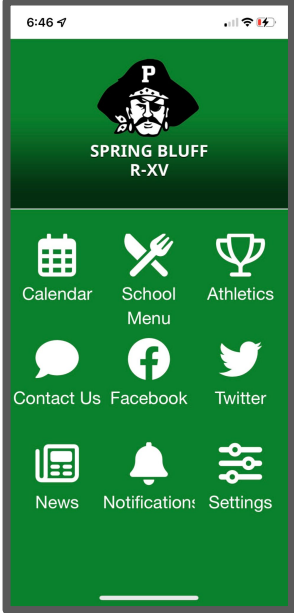
