Band students will assemble their instrument in the music room, then bring them down to their seat in the gym prior to the concert.


Don't forget to wear your holiday best! Students will go sit with their family once their portion of the performance is complete.




STEM CLUB

COUNSELOR'S CORNER

Anxiety has become a widely discussed topic and area of concern for many. Parents have had increased concerns about anxiousness in their children for the past several years.

"In a new article published last week (March 2022) in <u>JAMA Pediatrics</u>, researchers from the Health Resources and Services Administration find that anxiety and depression among children ages 3-17 have increased over the last five years. The researchers use data from the National Survey of Children's Health to look at trends in children's health, care utilization, and family circumstances from 2016-2020."
