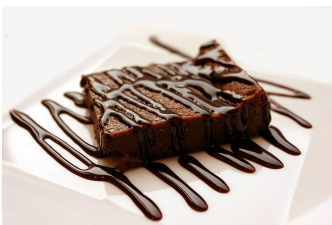
## RAFFLE TICKETS
