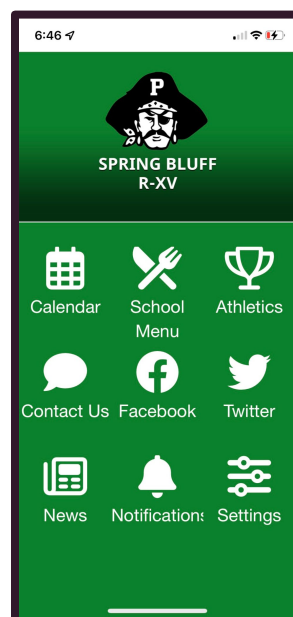
Welcome Back, Pirates!

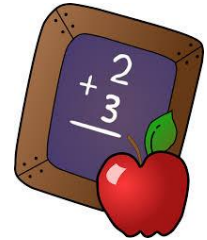
